RATIFYING MUNICIPAL WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Washington County Board of Commissioners acting through the Washington County Planning Commission have developed a new Municipal Waste Management Plan for Washington County dated June 1989 in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act of 1988 (Act 101); and

WHEREAS, the Washington County Board of Commissioners have approved and adopted the Municipal Waste Management Plan for Washington County dated June 1989 as the Official County Plan pursuant to the requirements of Section 501 of the Pennsylvania Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act of 1988 (Act 101); and


WHEREAS, the Council of Charleroi Borough have reviewed and approved the recommendations of the Municipal Waste Management Plan for Washington County dated June 1989 and the proposed plan to insure the availability of adequate permitted processing and disposal capacity for the municipal waste generated within Washington County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of Charleroi Borough does hereby approve and ratify the Municipal Waste Management Plan for Washington County dated June 1989 pursuant to the requirements of Section 503 of the Pennsylvania Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act of 1988 (Act 101).

RESOLUTION #2
FOR 1990

WHEREAS, the County of Washington (County) has been designated as an Urban County and, as such, annually receives funds under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program; and

WHEREAS, because the Borough of Charleroi (Borough) has agreed to cooperate with the County to assist it in securing designation as an Urban County; and

WHEREAS, as a part of its Fiscal Year 1990 (Sixteenth Year) Urban County Program, the County will make available an estimated amount of \$194,500 to be expended in the Borough on eligible activities with adjustment made for any additional reductions the County receives in its allocation; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to inform the County of the eligible projects it desires to see funded so that the County can complete its funding application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Charleroi that it hereby requests that the County of Washington expend Fiscal Year (Sixteenth Year) Community Development Block Grant funds on the following projects.:

1. Homeowner's Rehabilitation Program - \$75,000.
2. Street Improvements - an estimated amount of \$119,500
 - a. Shady Avenue - Sixth Street to Eighth Street
 - b. Seventh Street - Shady Avenue to Meadow Avenue

RESOLUTION #3

SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL #472

Between the

and
Redevelopment Authority of the County of Washington

MADE AND ENTERED into this 12th day of June, 1990,
by and between the BOROUGH OF CHARLEROI, a municipal subdivision of the
Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, with offices located at Fourth and Fallowfield
Avenue, Charleroi, Pennsylvania 15022 (hereinafter called "BOROUGH")

AND

REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF WASHINGTON, a body corporate and
politic, with principal offices located at 603 Courthouse Square, 100 West
Beau Street, Washington, Pennsylvania 15301 (hereafter called "AUTHORITY").

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Authority of the County of Washington
has been authorized to apply and administer funds obtained from the Pennsylvania
Department of Community Affairs for the Fallowfield Avenue Downtown Public
Site Improvements Project, Phase II; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Charleroi recognizes that a local share
of \$300,000 is required to match the Pennsylvania Department of Community
Affairs Redevelopment Assistance Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein
contained, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Borough recognizes that the Authority is the official
agency charged with responsibility for securing a Pennsylvania Department
of Community Affairs grant for the Fallowfield Avenue Downtown Public Site
Improvements Project, Phase II.

2. The Borough's local matching share is to be provided by
the County of Washington from Urban County Community Development Block

RESOLUTION #4

RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF CHARLEROI AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A PROPOSAL FOR FUNDS WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, IN CONNECTION WITH THE FALLOWFIELD AVENUE DOWNTOWN PUBLIC SITE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, PHASE II, IN THE BOROUGH OF CHARLEROI, PENNSYLVANIA AND ENTERING INTO A COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF WASHINGTON

WHEREAS, the Borough of Charleroi is desirous of obtaining funds from the Pennsylvania Department of Community Affairs in the amount of \$300,000 for prevention and elimination of blight under 4(c) of the Housing and Development Assistance Law, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council conducted a public meeting on June 12, 1990 on the Proposal and is aware that a local matching share is required; and

WHEREAS, the Borough requests that the Redevelopment Authority of the County of Washington administer the project in accordance with applicable State requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Charleroi that a blighting influence exists in the Fallowfield Avenue Downtown Public Site Improvements Project Area, Phase II because of the inadequate and deteriorating infrastructure and the proposed project will prevent further blight and/or eliminate the existing blighting influence by upgrading public improvements to contemporary standards which will stabilize the commercial district.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Charleroi will assume the provision of the local share, which shall be provided by the County of Washington from the Urban County Community Development Block Grant Program.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the proper Borough officers are authorized to enter into the attached Cooperation Agreement with the Redevelopment
