## **RESOLUTION #1 OF 2007**

### **IMPLEMENTING THE NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM**

**WHEREAS, the President directed the Secretary of the Department OF Homeland Security to develop and administer a National Incident Management System (NIMS), which would provide a consistent nationwide approach for federal, state & local governments to work together more effectively and efficiently to prevent, prepare for, respond to, and recover from domestic incidents, regardless of cause, size or complexity; and**

**WHEREAS, the collective input and guidance from all federal, state & local governments has been, and will continue to be, vital to the development, effective implementation and utilization of a comprehensive NIMS: and**

**WHEREAS, to facilitate the most efficient and effective incident management, it is critical that federal, state & local organizations utilize standardized terminology, standardized organizational structures, interoperable communications, consolidated action plans, unified command structures, uniform personnel qualification standards, uniform standards for planning, training, and exercising, comprehensive resource management, and designated incident facilities during emergencies or disasters; and**

**WHEREAS, the NIMS standardized procedures for managing personnel, communications, facilities and resources will improve the Borough of Charleroi, Washington County, Pennsylvania in its ability to utilize federal & state funding to enhance the Borough of Charleroi's readiness, maintain first responder safety and streamline incident management processes; and**

**WHEREAS, the Incident Command System components of NIMS are already part of various incident management activities throughout**

the state, including all public safety and emergency response organizations training programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Charleroi, Washington County, Pennsylvania adopts the National Incident Management System utilized by all incident management in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

- Implement a Public Information System by adhering to processes, procedures, and/or plans to communicate timely, accurate information to the public during an incident through a Joint Information System and Joint Information Center.

## Preparedness: Planning

- Establish the community's NIMS baseline against the FFY 2005 and FFY 2006 implementation requirements.
- Develop and implement a system to coordinate all federal preparedness funding to implement the NIMS across the community.
- Revise and update plans and Standard Operating Procedures to incorporate NIMS components, principles and policies, to include planning, training, response, exercises, equipment, evaluation, and corrective actions.
- Participate in and promote intrastate and interagency mutual aid agreements, to include agreements with the private sector and non-governmental organizations.

## Preparedness: Training

- Complete the IS 700 NIMS: An Introduction; IS 800 NRP: An Introduction; ICS 100 and ICS 200 courses as applicable to the position personnel serve under the Incident Command System and the Training Matrix enclosed with this letter.

## Preparedness: Exercises

- Incorporate NIMS/ICS into all local and regional training and exercises.
- Participate in an all-hazard exercise program based on NIMS that involves responders from multiple disciplines and multiple jurisdictions.
- Incorporate corrective actions into preparedness and response plans and procedures.

## Resource Management


- Inventory community response assets to conform to homeland security resource typing standards.
- To the extent permissible by law, ensure that relevant national standards and guidance to achieve equipment, communication, and data interoperability are incorporated into local acquisition programs.

## Communication & Information Management

- Apply standardized and consistent terminology, including the establishment of plain English communications standards across the public safety sector.



WHEREAS, a Resolution is required to reduce or eliminate Participant Contributions on an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, the consultant for the Police Pension Plan of the Borough of Charleroi, as evidenced by the latest actuarial study and minimum municipal obligation, has determined that if Participant Contributions to the Police Pension Plan are eliminated, the Borough of Charleroi Police Pension Plan will not require additional contributions by the Borough, this determination is further based on assumption that state pension aid will be sufficient to cover the plan's funding requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby resolved by the Borough Council of the Borough of Charleroi that effective January 1, 2008 and continuing through and including December 31, 2008, the amount of Participant Contributions due shall be zero percent (0%) of compensation. The obligation to pay Participant Contributions pursuant to Act 600 shall resume effective January 1, 2009.

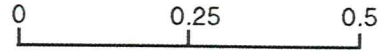
