

**WHEREAS,** The Real Estate Tax Collector for the Borough of Charleroi has requested that she be permitted to accept credit card payments through the Muni-Pay program;

**BE IT RESOLVED,** The Borough of Charleroi consents to providing taxpayers the option of paying their taxes through the use of a credit card. As such payment is dependent upon receipt of actual payment of the amount of the taxes from the credit card company, the taxes shall be considered paid when actual payment from the credit card company is received. No part of the credit card transaction paying Borough taxes shall include a convenience fee or user charge to the taxpayer. Any such fees imposed by Muni-Pay, its affiliates or the credit card companies shall be done as a separate transaction with the taxpayer.




**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF CHARLEROI, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING THAT THE REAL ESTTE TAX COLLECTOR SHALL HAVE ABOND IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAN THIRTY PERCENT (30%) OF THE TAX DUPLICATE OR THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF TAX TO BE COLLECTED.**

**WHEREAS**, the Pennsylvania Fiscal Code 72 Pa.C.S.A. § 5511.4 requires the real estate tax collector for the Borough of Charleroi to post a bond;

**BE IT RESOLVED**, the bond of the real estate tax collector shall be a smaller designated amount than the total amount of the tax duplicate, however, the amount of the bond shall not be less than thirty percent (30%) of the tax duplicate or the estimated amount of the tax to be collected. The estimated amount for 2010 Borough real estate tax based upon a total assessed real estate value of \$ 16,726, 034.00 at 42.15 mills will be \$ 733,874. The required bond will be in an amount no less than \$ 220,162.







1. Certification is made to the Authority that all necessary legal steps, certifications, notices, hearings, and other proceedings necessary to be taken by the Borough under the Borough Code, have been taken and completed in accordance with the appropriate rules, regulations, statutes and ordinances with regard to the demolition of the structures hereinafter enumerated.



A Resolution encouraging the Pennsylvania General Assembly to Pass a Statewide Lost or Stolen  
Handgun Reporting Law

**WHEREAS**, gun violence is an increasing public health concern in our municipality, our region, and our Commonwealth – taking the lives of more than 1,200 Pennsylvanians each year, and

**WHEREAS**, 22 police officers have been shot and killed in the line of duty in Pennsylvania in the last ten years, including 7 in the last year alone, and

**WHEREAS**, the vast majority of crimes committed with guns are committed by individuals who are already prohibited from bearing arms because of a previous felony conviction or other exclusion – who obtain handguns illegally through straw-purchases, traffickers or theft, and

**WHEREAS**, in Pennsylvania there is no legal duty for handgun owners to report missing firearms to the police, and

**WHEREAS**, requiring that lost or stolen handguns be reported to the police within a reasonable time after their absence is discovered, would help law enforcement officers identify and prosecute criminals who use and traffic illegal handguns, while encouraging responsible practices among law abiding handgun owners, and

**WHEREAS**, states that have already adopted lost or stolen handgun reporting requirements (Connecticut, Massachusetts, Michigan, New Jersey, New York, Ohio and Rhode Island), exhibit a 2/3 reduction in the number of crime guns traced back to within their borders, and

**WHEREAS**, 23 communities in Pennsylvania have already adopted local lost or stolen handgun reporting ordinances – including the largest cities in the state as well as many suburban and small rural towns, and


**WHEREAS**, the Pennsylvania State Police, the International Association of Chiefs of Police, the Pennsylvania Chiefs of Police Association, the Pennsylvania District Attorneys' Association, and our own highest ranking police officer, Superintendent Michael Matyas, have considered a lost or stolen handgun reporting requirement and determined that it would be a valuable tool to identify and bring to justice criminals who use and traffic illegal handguns,

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Borough of Charleroi Council calls upon the Pennsylvania General Assembly, particularly our local State Representative Peter J Daley and Senator Barry Stout, to follow the example set by 23 Pennsylvania communities, seven states and the advice of every major law enforcement organization in the state – by adopting a statewide law requiring lost or stolen handguns to be reported missing to the police within a reasonable period of time after the discovery of their absence.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that a copy of this resolution shall be transmitted immediately to the Pennsylvania General Assembly and to the Governor of Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, Act 600 further provides that Participant Contributions into the Charleroi Borough Police Pension Plan by Participants may be reduced or eliminated; and

WHEREAS, a Resolution is required to reduce or eliminate Participant Contributions on an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, the consultant for the Police Pension Plan of the Borough of Charleroi, as evidenced by the most recent Act 205 Actuarial Valuation Report and minimum municipal obligation, has determined that if Participant Contributions to the Police Pension Plan are eliminated, the Borough of Charleroi Police Pension Plan will not require additional contributions by the Borough, this determination is further based on assumption that state pension aid will be sufficient to cover the plan's funding requirements;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby resolved by the Borough Council of the Borough of Charleroi that effective January 1, 2011 and continuing through and including December 31, 2011, the amount of Participant Contributions due shall be zero percent (0%) of compensation. The obligation to pay Participant Contributions pursuant to Act 600 shall resume effective January 1, 2012.



**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the BOROUGH OF CHARLEROI, Washington County, Pennsylvania, as follows:


