WHEREAS, the Borough of Charleroi has undertaken numerous community development strategies to enhance our resident's quality of life; and

WHEREAS, Charleroi Borough Council has determined to perform a condition assessment of the existing sanitary sewer infrastructure; and

ORDINANCE NO. 2^A OF 2018

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE JOINING OF THE MID MON VALLEY COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS

The [City/Borough/Township] of Charleroi hereby ordains and enacts as follows:

Section 1. Authorization. This Ordinance is authorized pursuant to Section 2303 of the Pennsylvania Intragovernmental Cooperation Act, as codified, 53 Pa.C.S. § 2303.

Section 2. Purpose. The Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments has been formed and is designed:

- (a) to promote cost saving, shared services, and joint purchasing among the political subdivisions and municipalities of the Middle Monongahela Valley region; and
- (b) to be beneficial to the citizens and taxpayers of the Middle Monongahela Valley region through increased access to programs and grants and savings of taxpayer monies through shared services and joint bidding and letting of contracts.

Section 3. Conditions. The Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments shall operate pursuant to the binding vote of the members of the Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments, as said membership is established herein.

Section 4. Membership and Organizational Structure. Membership in the Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments shall be by affirmative vote of this governing body. The governing body shall then elect one permanent and one alternate delegate to participate in the Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments General Assembly.

Section 5. Authority of Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments. The Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments shall have the authority and power to enter into contracts to which this municipality is bound based upon the affirmative vote of the General Assembly of the Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments.

Section 6. Duration. The Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments shall exist until such time as an affirmative vote of the General Assembly of the Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments acts to disband, dissolve, or otherwise discontinue the Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments.

Section 7. Budget.

- (a) For the first operating year of the Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments, this municipality shall not authorize any funds to be used to fund the Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments.

(b) For every year thereafter, and recognizing the benefit conferred upon this municipality by the Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments, this municipality shall commit an annual membership dues to be determined on an annual basis; provided, that the Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments shall provide a minimum of 180 days' notice of the annual membership due amount.

(c) This municipality authorizes the Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments to submit competitive bids for services, supplies, and other resources; provided, that this municipality shall reserve the right to voluntarily opt out of any bid process at any time.

Section 8. Opt Out. Notwithstanding any provision of this Ordinance, this municipality shall have the option to opt out of the Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments at any time; provided, that exercising said option shall not permit this municipality to recover any dues or fees already paid or due to be paid to the Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments at the time of exercising said option; provided, further, that at the time said opt out occurs, this municipality shall not be liable for any dues owing to in the future or fees incurred by the Mid Mon Valley Council of Governments after the date of exercising said option.

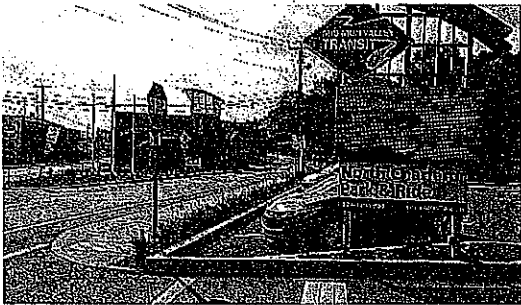

The MMVTA operates fixed route, public bus service throughout the Mid Mon Valley and into downtown



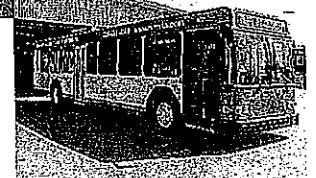
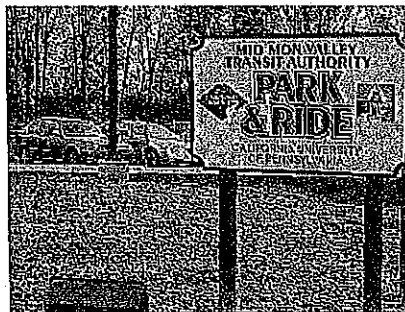
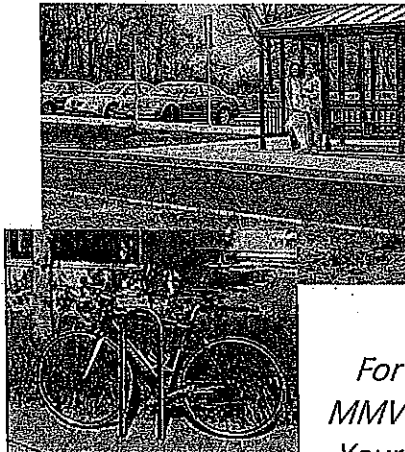
Pittsburgh – providing service to over 300,000 riders per year (12% of riders are Senior Citizens and 14% of riders are Persons with a Disability). For those who, due to a disability, cannot utilize this fixed route service, we offer ADA complementary paratransit service which operates in the local service area during the same days and hours as local fixed route buses. The MMVTA is governed by a Board of Directors which consists of community-appointed Board Members from most of the Mid Mon Valley

communities. The MMVTA has a small administrative staff and contracts out their transportation services to private contractors.

MMVTA's administrative offices are located in Charleroi and their newly renovated Bus Storage & Maintenance Facilities are located in Donora and PennDOT just opened a new CNG fueling station at this site as well. MMVTA has a fleet of 29 buses (8 of which are CNG buses & 7 more CNG buses will be delivered later in 2018) and offers the public amenities such as: park & ride lots, bus shelters, automated vehicle location capabilities, and Wi-Fi on the buses.

To enhance services provided to your community, current projects underway in 2018 and 2019 include, but are not limited to, the following:

- ✓ Equip transit buses with bike racks and enhance designated shelters and park & ride lots with bike related accessories – Summer 2018.
- ✓ Security Camera Systems upgraded/installed at the Crookham Park & Ride Lot and at the Cal U Park & Ride Lot – Spring/Summer 2018.
- ✓ Continue replacement of remaining diesel-fueled buses with CNG Buses – 2018 & 2019.
